

Yahoo – HOW TO ADD SENDERS TO YOUR INBOX

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To get autoresponder emails into your Yahoo inbox, **mark existing ones as "Not Spam," add the sender to your contacts ([whitelist](#)), and create a [filter](#)** to automatically move them to the inbox, as Yahoo's filters learn from your actions and these steps train them to trust the sender for future mailings.

1. Train Yahoo's Filter (Immediate Action)

- **Move from Spam:** Open your Spam folder, select the legitimate emails, and click "Not Spam" or "Mark as not spam" to move them to your inbox and teach the filter.

2. Add Sender to Contacts (Whitelist)

- **For a Specific Email:** Open the email, click the sender's name or address to view details, and add them to your contacts.
- **For a List/Sender:** Create a new contact and give the sender/list a name (e.g., "Newsletter Name").

3. Create a Filter (For Future Emails)

- **From an Email:** Open a message from the autoresponder, click the three dots (More icon), select "Filter messages like this," choose "Inbox," and click "Save".
- **From Settings:** Go to Settings (gear icon) > More Settings > Filters > Add new filter. Set criteria (sender's email) and choose "Inbox" as the destination.

4. Other Tips

- **Check Filters:** Ensure you don't have a faulty filter sending wanted emails to Trash or Spam in your settings.
- **Unsubscribe:** If it's a mailing list you don't want, use the "Unsubscribe" option within the email if available, instead of marking as spam.
